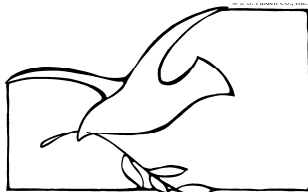

**FOOLISHNESS**

Sometimes the idea of repentance seems old-fashioned, naïve, even foolish. But if you're looking for real foolishness, you'll find it in today's readings.

We begin with Leviticus and the admonition, "Take no revenge and cherish no grudge" (Leviticus 19:18). We've heard that message before, of course, so we might forget how far it is from the so-called "practical realities of life." Saint Paul warns us about being practical, though. Whoever considers oneself wise had better "become a fool," because "the wisdom of this world is foolishness in the eyes of God" (1 Corinthians 3:18, 19).

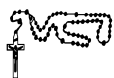
This "foolishness" continues in the Gospel: "Offer no resistance to one who is evil" (Matthew 5:39). In fact, offer the other cheek when you've been slapped. Hand over your coat as well as your shirt. Be like God, who sends sunshine and rain on the bad as well as the good. "So be perfect," says Jesus, "just as your heavenly Father is perfect" (5:48).

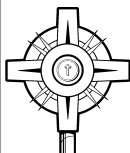

**"FEAST OF FAITH"**

*A weekly series on the parts of the Mass to help us prepare for the changes in the English translation of the Mass coming at the end of the year.*

**The Opening Prayer**

At the conclusion of the Introductory Rites of the Mass, the presider says or chants the words "Let us pray," followed by the Opening Prayer. This prayer is also called a "collect" because it gathers or "collects" the prayers of the entire assembly into one. The Roman collects that we pray in our liturgy—noted for the brevity, clarity, and conciseness of the Latin originals—date from a variety of periods. Some are quite new; others reach back more than a thousand years. They are truly treasures of our tradition.

The Opening Prayer can be divided into four main parts: 1) the invitation, or "Let us pray"; 2) the silence that follows, during which each member of the assembly lifts up before God his or her own prayers; 3) the collect itself, spoken or sung by the priest; 4) and finally the Amen, by which the assembly says, "yes," "may it be so," making the prayer their own.

The collect itself almost always follows the same pattern. It begins with an invocation to God. A petition follows, usually very general. We ask for health, strength, wisdom, grace, forgiveness, faith, awareness. Every collect concludes by offering the prayer to God through Jesus Christ. With the Amen of the assembly, the Introductory Rites of the Mass come to an end.

## *A Letter From Our Pastor* The New Roman Missal



Dear Parishioners of Blessed Sacrament Church,

There is a new English edition of the Roman Missal to be used at Mass beginning the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011.

- While the *parts* of the Mass will not change, some *prayers* of the Mass have been revised with a new English translation.
- This translation was prompted by the third edition of the Roman Missal in Latin. This third edition updates the Missal with the Masses for the many new saints and blessed which were named during the pontificate of Pope John Paul II. It also adds several texts for Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary, as well as Masses for various needs.
- The new English text will match more closely the Latin text, which draws on the richness of Sacred Scripture, as well as on other prayers from the Church's tradition. The language has been described as more elevated, poetic, and humble in style. It directs our attention to the fact that at Holy Mass we are not doing something ordinary or routine. At every Mass we offer a special act of worship to God, Who is unlike any other person in our experience. The language we use at Mass helps us to keep that in mind.
- The translation in the new Missal presents a richer expression of the two-thousand-year tradition of prayer in the church.
- The new Missal better reflects our identity as the Catholic Church. English-speaking peoples throughout the world will be praying the Mass with thoughts and ideas which more closely reflect those of our brothers and sisters who speak other languages. A revision of the Missal in other languages is also underway.

This is an exciting time for our parish, our diocese, and the universal Church. Throughout this year, we will have continuing education in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the new Roman Missal. Please plan to attend!

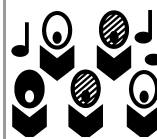
