

Blessed Sacrament School - Instructions for School Application

Your application is not considered complete until all of the documents below have been submitted.

Separate application documents are required for each student.

**If you apply during our March registration period,
you will be notified of your child's enrollment status on or
before March 31.**

Early Childhood Center (ECC)

1. Complete and return the following forms:

- Application for Admission – Diocese of Arlington (yellow)
- ECC Application/class selection (yellow)
- ECC Parent Questionnaire (pink)
- **For 5-Day class only:** ECC Student Information Form (pink)

2. Paper clip your \$25 check to the application.

The only fee due today is the application fee of \$25 per child. Make check payable to Blessed Sacrament School (“application fee” in memo line). One check per family is allowed.

- Upon acceptance into the school the registration fee as well as first month's tuition will be due to secure the slot. Not paying these fees on time forfeits your class spot.

3. Please also attach a copy of your child's birth certificate and baptismal certificate (if Catholic).

Grade School (K-8)

1. Complete and return the following forms:

- Application for Admission – Diocese of Arlington. (yellow) **Items 5 and 6 will be provided by the current school via our transcript request/Release of Records form.**
- Parent Questionnaire (dk. yellow)
- Release of Records (incoming grades 1-8 only) (white)
- Middle School Student Questionnaire (incoming grades 6-8 only) (dk. yellow)

2. Paper clip your \$25 check to the application.

The only fee due today is the application fee of \$25 per child. Make check payable to Blessed Sacrament School (“application fee” in memo line). One check per family is allowed.

- Upon acceptance into the school the registration, workbook, and technology fees, as well as first month's tuition will be due to secure the slot. Not paying these fees on time forfeits your class spot.

3. Please also attach a copy of your child's birth certificate and baptismal certificate (if Catholic). If you are Catholic but you are a non-parishioner, you will need to provide proof of current parish registration before receiving the Catholic/Non-Parish tuition rate.
