Kindergarten

PLEASE DON'T LABEL SUPPLIES

Middle School Supply List 2010-2011

In order to streamline the middle school supply list and to help students manage their course materials, the middle school teachers propose to purchase most of the supplies that the students will need. A supply fee will be charged to cover the cost of the materials, and you will benefit from the economy of bulk purchasing.
