**Kindergarten**

**PLEASE DON'T LABEL SUPPLIES**

- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons (16 to 24 count) No thick crayons
  - 1 box of regular #2 pencils (sharpened yellow pencils)

  - 6 large glue sticks
  - 2 boxes of Crayola thick markers - classic colors only

## **Middle School Supply List 2011-2012**

In order to streamline the middle school supply list and help students manage their course materials, the middle school teachers purchase most of the

supplies that the students will need. A supply fee will be charged to cover the cost of the materials, and you will benefit from the economy of bulk purchasing.

**Students are asked to purchase the following supplies on their own, some of which are given to the teacher on the first day for the class supply**

**Sharpened** yellow #2 pencils

Ball point pens, blue or black ink (two packs)

Ball point pens red ink

**Only** yellow highlighters

Ruler - metric and conventional

Sharpened colored pencils

Colored markers
